

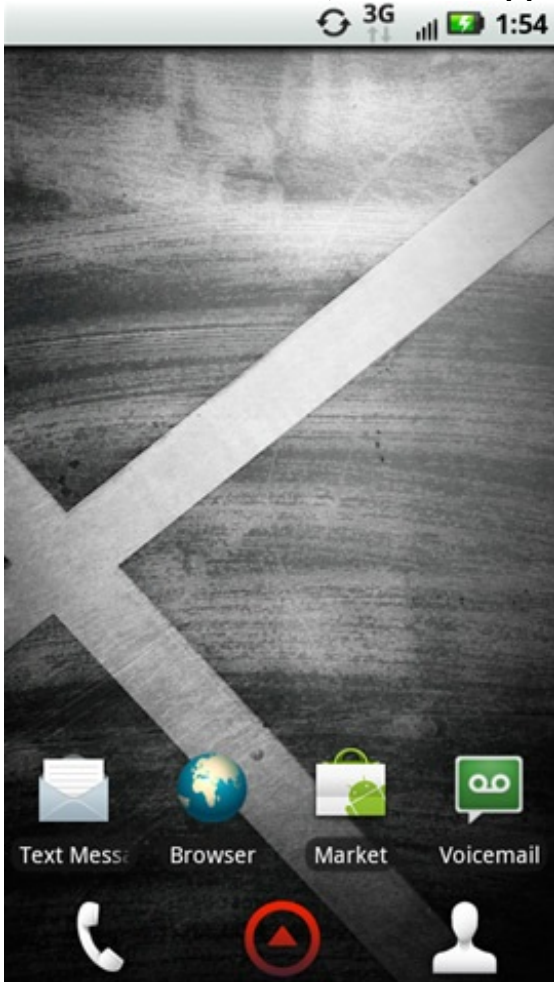

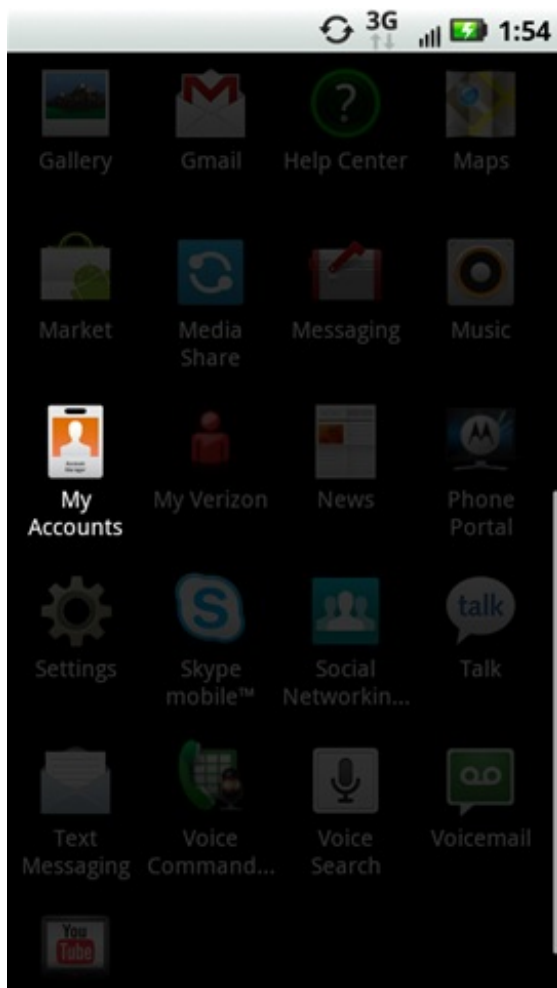

Follow these directions for setting up a Android phone with Kerio hosted email.

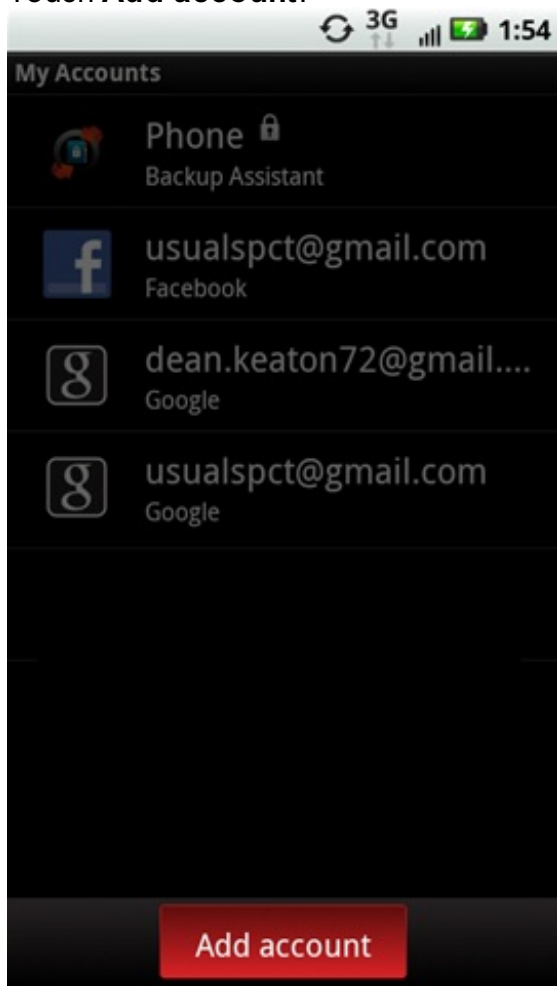
1. From the home screen, touch the **applications tab** (located at the bottom of the display).



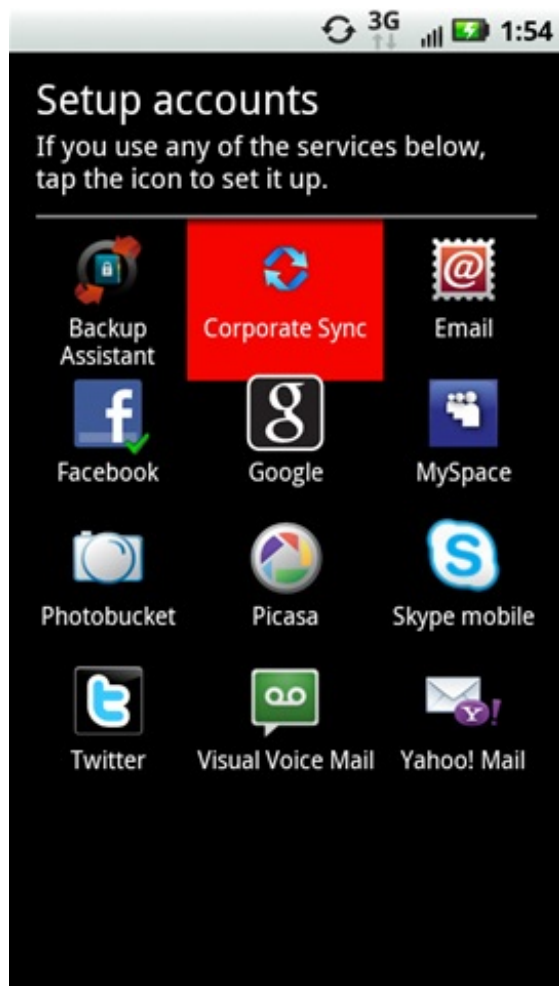
2. Touch **My Accounts** .




